The Expected Family Contribution (EFC)

- Amount family can reasonably be expected to contribute
- Calculated using FAFSA data and a federal formula
- Usually stays the same at all colleges

Cost of Attendance

- Tuition and fees
- Room and board
- Books, supplies, transportation, and miscellaneous personal expenses, including documented costs for a personal computer
- Loan fees
